Glossary of terms

Lead Provider – DfE approved organisation responsible for the creation and dissemination of DfE accredited programmes offered throughout the UK to a network of delivery partners.

Local Delivery Partner - school, school alliance, multi-academy trust(s) or other organisation that has significant strategic, operational and administrative capacity to contribute to the delivery of ETH activity.



Strategic Partner - school, school alliance or multi-academy trust(s) that either formed part of the initial Hub application, or have joined the strategic group to offer local expertise and experience

Support Partner - school, school alliance or multi-academy trust(s) that contributes to the operational leadership and delivery of ETH activity.

Member – participants, alumni, facilitators, schools, trusts and other organisations who benefit from the Hub programmes and communications.
