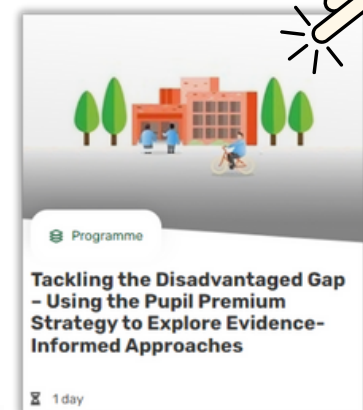
Focused on addressing local challenges, our evidence informed CPD includes:

National Professional Qualifications

This has been a truly exciting half term for NPQs, applications for Cohort 5 have now closed and we now have over 170 participants signed up to join us from November, across the full suite of UCL programmes.

If you missed out on applying for an NPQ this time, don't worry! Applications for Cohort 6, with programmes starting in the Spring term, open on the 16th October.

May 2023 was the first assessment window for the reformed leadership NPQs. We are delighted with the outcomes achieved by our participants. Our NPQH groups achieved an amazing 100% pass rate, compared to 97.1% nationally and our NPQSL groups achieved 99% pass rate compared to 96.5% nationally. This reflects our expert, high quality facilitation and the commitment shown by all participants. Congratulations to all involved.

Our cohort 3 specialist NPQ participants will be completing their summative assessments at the start of October. We wish them every success and look forward to another set of excellent outcomes.

Applications for our NPQs starting in spring 2024 open on 16th October and close 18th January 2024. We are looking forward to delivering a new NPQ programme in 2024: NPQ Leading Primary Mathematics. Further details will be released during the coming weeks.
